

Grace Prep T-shirt, Outerwear, and Specialty Item policy

- Dean of Students approves all organization wear, spirit wear, etc.
- Dean of Athletics approves all team wear, team booster wear, etc.
- Grace Prep T-Shirt Guidelines
 - Shirt color options
 - Navy blue
 - Gold
 - Light blue
 - Yellow
 - White
 - Gray
 - The only exception: Each class (Freshmen – Seniors) may select a unique color for their class shirts.
 - Colors must be approved by the Dean of Students
 - Fluorescent colors are a possibility.
 - Tie-dye and camo are not options.
 - The t-shirt must have the words Grace Prep, Lions, GPA or the Grace Prep Logo, clearly and prominently visible on the front of the shirt.
 - Designs and messages on all T-shirts must be in good taste; student organizations and teams may not sell or distribute T-shirts that do not fit the Christian mission and character of the school.
 - Designs containing non-GPA trademarks or phrases (i.e. Coke, cartoon characters, etc.) must have written permission from the copyright or trademark owner before the design will be approved.
 - T-shirt approval forms must be submitted and approved by the appropriate Dean before T-shirts may be purchased and distributed.
- Grace Prep Outerwear Guidelines
 - Outerwear color options
 - Navy Blue
 - Gold
 - White
 - Gray
 - Outerwear must have the words Grace Prep, Lions, GPA or the Grace Prep Logo, clearly and prominently visible on the front of the shirt.
 - Designs and messages on all outerwear must be in good taste; student organizations or teams may not sell or distribute T-shirts that do not fit the Christian mission and character of the school.
 - Designs containing non-GPA trademarks or phrases (i.e. Coke, cartoon characters, etc.) must have written permission from the copyright or trademark owner before the design will be approved.
 - Outerwear approval forms must be submitted and approved by the appropriate Dean before outerwear may be purchased and distributed.
- Specialty Items
 - All specialty items (stadium seats, hats, etc.) must be approved by the appropriate Dean.
